Police Reserve applicants undergo careful screening and considerable training to develop the necessary skills needed to support our full-time officers.

The application process generally takes about two months. Applicants must satisfactorily complete a personal history statement, oral interview, polygraph examination, medical examination, psychological evaluation and thorough background review. Special attention will be placed on honesty and past drug involvement.
